All of these items must have State, township and HHCA approval and permits. These structures are a liability for all of us. Do not put a structure like this on your property without approval.

As most of us realize, it is not possible to repair roads during the winter months in Michigan. Therefore, when the entrance off of M-59 deteriorated there was nothing to be done. If we had attempted to fill the holes the water and ice would have loosen the filler and traffic would have thrown the material out. The Board in negotiation with several asphalt companies made repairs by totally replacing the asphalt in the exit area that had deteriorated. The asphalt plants do not open until the weather breaks, therefore repairs could not be made until late April. The Board was and continues to be concern about the roads.

All homeowners need to regularly check their road drains and other drains for a build-up of debris around the drain opening. As many of you know if debris is not kept cleared from around the drain opening it will mat down and stop water from entering the drain. If not kept clean then in the middle of a thunderstorm you will find yourself out in the rain raking/shoveling the debris in order to break open the drain opening to keep from flooding your street and yards. Also, please keep the small rocks and sand swept up along the curbs.

Please keep in mind that recreational vehicles are not to be stored within the Association area unless they are in the garage. We do allow three days for cleaning and preparation for use on your property then please make sure they are removed from the area.
