

**Perimeter Fencing of New In-ground Swimming Pools
and Dog Runs**

Policy No. 3

Adopted October 10, 2007

As of January 1, 2008, the Hickory Hills Board and Architectural control Committee (ACC) adopts the following policy regarding the perimeter fencing of new in-ground swimming pools and approved dog runs:

All fences shall be constructed so as not to interfere with the sightlines already established in the area surrounding the unit installing the pool or dog run.

Fences will be permanent in nature; constructed of wrought iron or aluminum, and be no taller than 48" from the existing grade. PVC, wood, chain-link and any other materials are not permitted.

If, for some reason, Oceola Township and/or Livingston County require a fence height greater than 48", then the individual requesting the permit to build will furnish such height requirements to the ACC prior to any excavation at the site.
