## Requirements for Outbuildings Within Hickory Hills condominium Association

## Policy 4

## Adopted August 29, 2007

All of the following requirements must be agreed to prior to approval by the ACC.

- 1. Must be no larger than on hundred (100) square feet of floor space
- 2. Must be no higher than twelve (12) feet at the highest external point as measured from the interior center point
- 3. Must be constructed of materials exactly matching the primary dwelling including but not limited to , asphalt shingles, vinyl siding, doors, et cetera and exactly match the architecture of the primary dwelling including roof pitch and overhangs
- 4. Must have a concrete floor of a minimum 4" depth prior to any perimeter construction
- 5. Must be constructed by a party holding a valid builder's License in the State of Michigan
- 6. Start-to-finish construction will be completed within 30 days of groundbreaking
- 7. All required township and county permits will be obtained and posted prior to the start of construction
- 8. Outbuilding may not be used for any commercial purposes
- 9. Pathway connection to existing features such as a deck, patio, or driveway is optional but if chosen, the material may not be dirt, gravel, slag, mulch, or wood chips. Concrete, asphalt, pavers, are strongly encouraged.
